Resource Geologist

Reporting to the Director of Technical Services, you will work with the mine and project staff to ensure compliance with Eldorado Gold Corporation's internal standards and the standards outlined in Canadian National Instrument 43-101. Your responsibilities will include:

- Working with the mine and project staff to ensure effective transfer and validation of drilling, assay and geological data needed to support modeling;
- Assisting in ensuring the integrity of resource databases;
- Assisting in creating or updating 3-D geological objects;
- Undertaking appropriate data analyses to support grade estimation;
- Assisting in developing and updating resource models;
- Working with mine and project staff to ensure all resource modeling work is properly documented (internal company reports) and displayed (appropriate scale sections and plans);
- Ensuring that resource model data, such as block model values and 3-D digital items, are formatted and stored in a form that will allow seamless transfer between different commercial mine planning software;
- Providing support and training for mine geology staff on maintaining and updating short term resource models (i.e. grade control models); and
- Assisting the Corporate Technical Services group in the timely and accurate estimation and reporting of year end mineral resources of our mines and projects.

Your qualifications in Geology or Geological Sciences will be supported by:

- Proven experience in project development and/or an operations environment, preferably in precious metals;
- Proficiency in mine planning software, such as Gemcom or Minesight;
- Good working knowledge of gold mineralization systems and structural geology;
- Basic understanding of statistics and data analysis;
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills;
- An ability to undertake some international travel to the various sites; and
- Membership of (or eligibility to join) the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of British Columbia.
